- Provide B-52 Training Systems continuing CLS and change management for concurrency and trainer-unique Reliability & Maintainability changes
- Requirements
  - ATD on-site: 95% availability

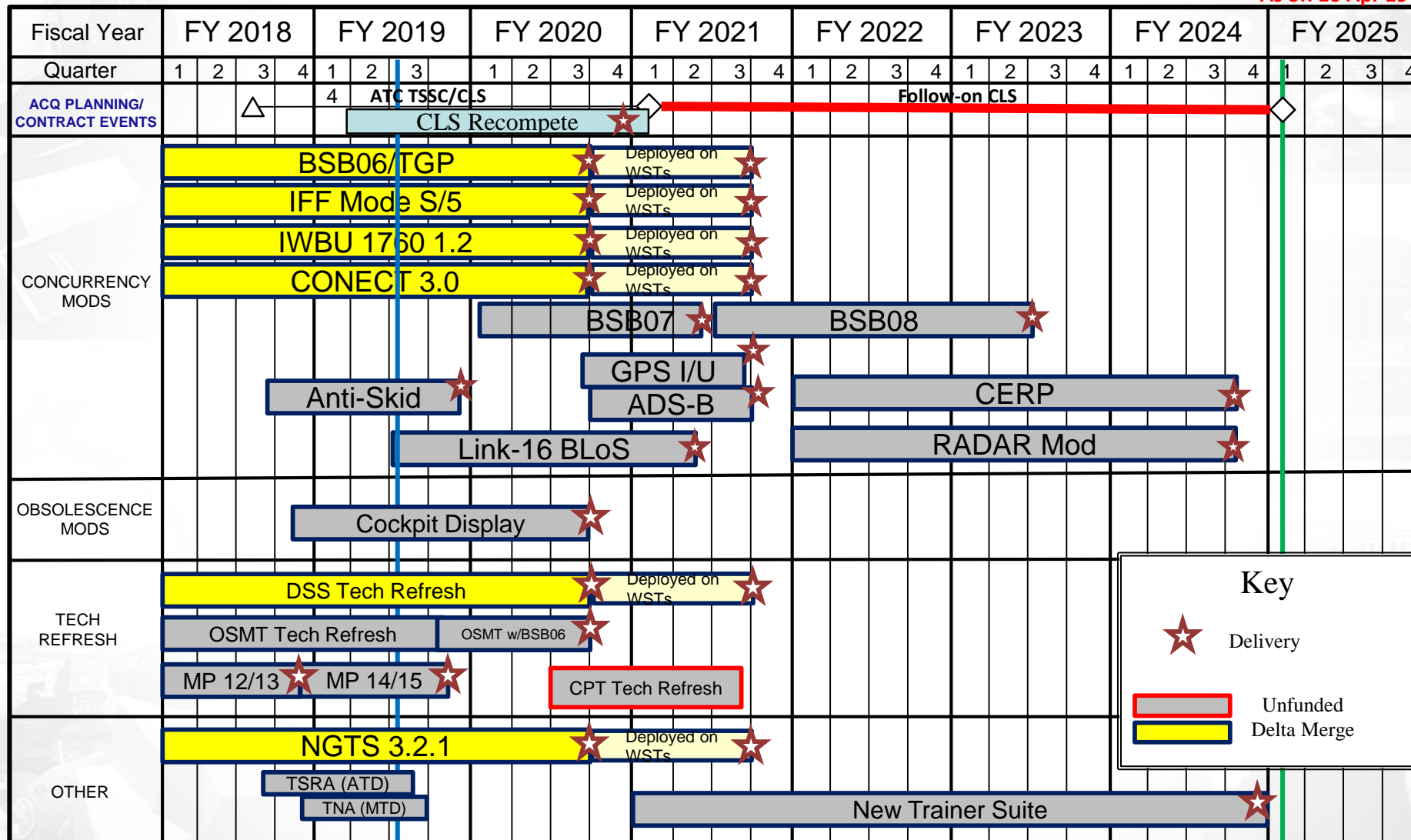


# Air Combat Execution Review

## Description

- 31 Total Trainers: 22 Full Mission Trainers (FMT), 9 Hands On Throttle And Stick (HOTAS) Trainers at 10 total locations (CONUS, OCONUS)
- The Training System Support Center (TSSC) and school house are located at Davis Monthan AFB, Tucson, AZ. They house all 9 HOTAS, 4 FMTs and a development FMT.
- 11 Brief/De-brief Systems at 10 locations
- Fully DMO-capable
- Major Customers: ACC, AFRC, ANG, PACAF

- Database Generation Systems



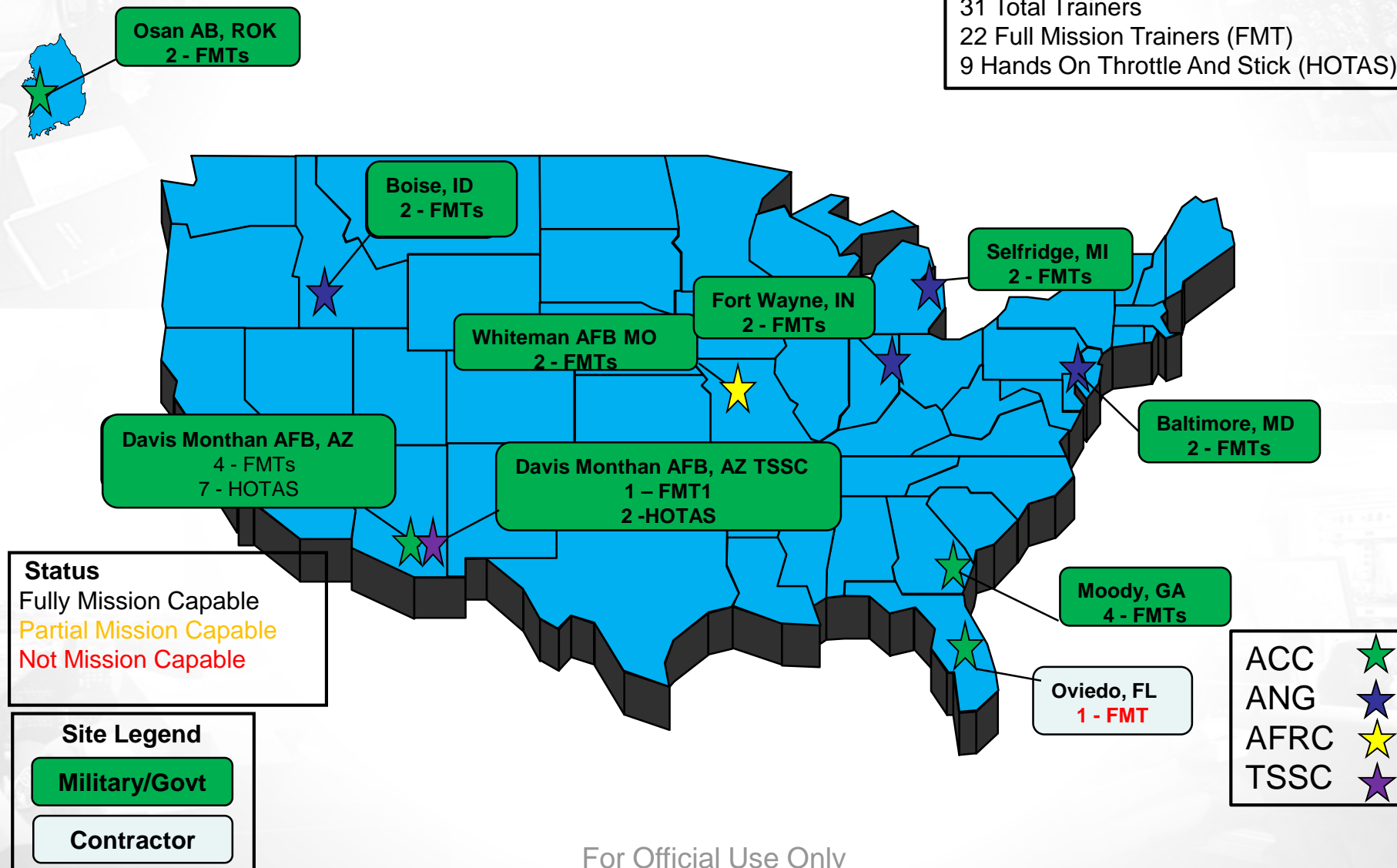
