Program Description


The mission of the KDAM ATARS Program is to train Pilots, Loadmasters, and Special Mission Aviators (SMAs) on five aircraft, UH-1N, HH-60G, HC/MC-130J, and CV-22. The program supports four MAJCOMS, AETC (Lead Command), AFGSC, ACC, and AFSOC. The KDAM ATARS Program consists 34 devices across four bases, Kirtland, Davis-Monthan, Andrews, and Moody Air Force Bases.



Trade Space to Consider:

- Continue “as is” scope of KDAM ATARS
- Align MDS, which would align PFT
- Separate PFT and Courseware onto their own contract
- Combine KDAM ATARS and AFSOC ACTS to become ATARS III (ACTS Options: Jan 24, Jan 25)

- AC-130J FTU Cannon AFB moves to Kirtland AFB FY24, Training Begins FY25
- HH-60W New Rotor Program will be acquired in FY24
- MH-139A New Rotor Program might be acquired in FY26 - HQ Training Maxwell AFB
- HC-130J New at Patrick AFB for AF Reserve – ACC in FY? Currently uses Moody AFB
 - Tee-up with the 2 CRH device delivery in FY26, Patrick AFB
- UH-1N and the HH-60G devices at KAFB need Concurrency/Projectors/Tech Refresh (20+ yrs old)
- Cloud Environment for Courseware
