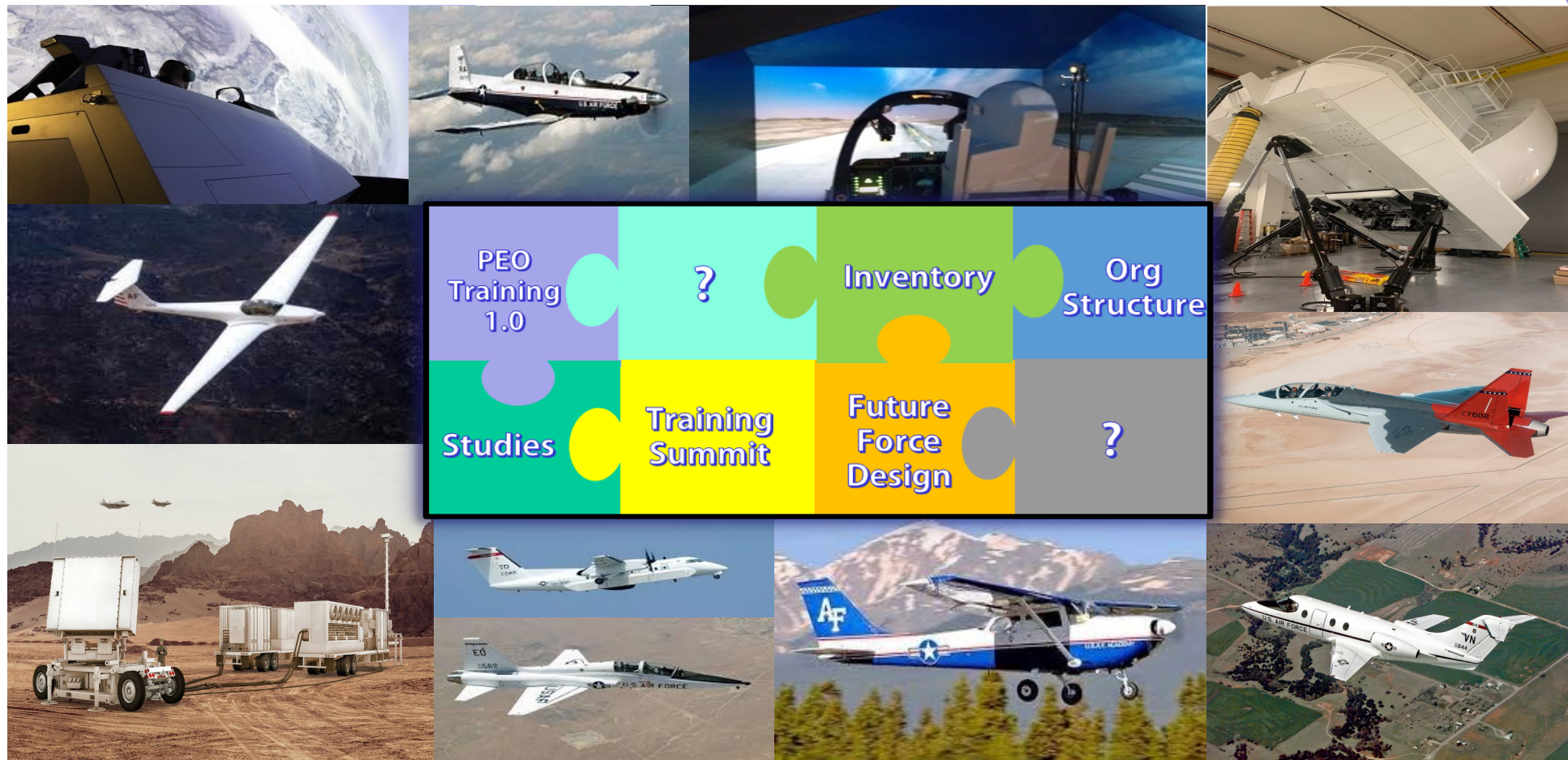

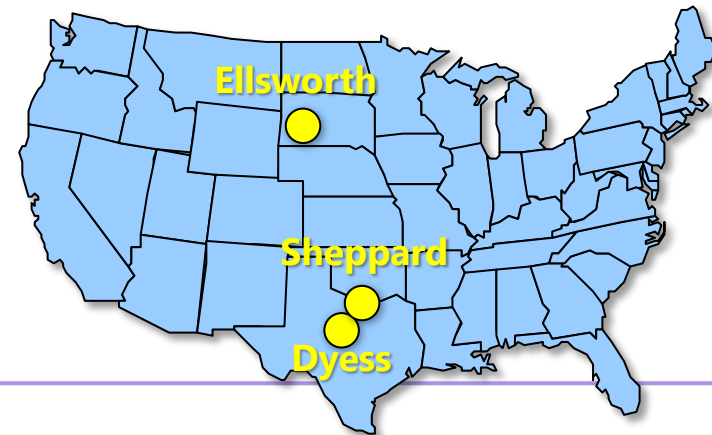

B-1 TRAINING SYSTEMS



- The B-1 Training Systems (TS) program consists of 20 Maintenance Training Devices (MTDs), 2 Cockpit Procedure Trainers (CPT), 2 Mission Trainers (MT), and 5 Weapon System Trainers (WST)
 - The B-1 WSTs provide development of proper aircrew coordination in comprehensive flight, mission, and tactics environments and provide initial avionics training
 - The B-1 MTDs are Trainer Field Equipment (TFE) which provide students with the ability to become proficient in the maintenance of the aircraft
- Using Organizations: AFGSC, AETC
- Provide B-1 TS Contractor Logistics Support (CLS) and change management for concurrency and trainer-unique Reliability & Maintainability updates
- Requirements:
 - Aircrew Training Device on-site: 95% availability
 - MTD on-call repair: 2 Days

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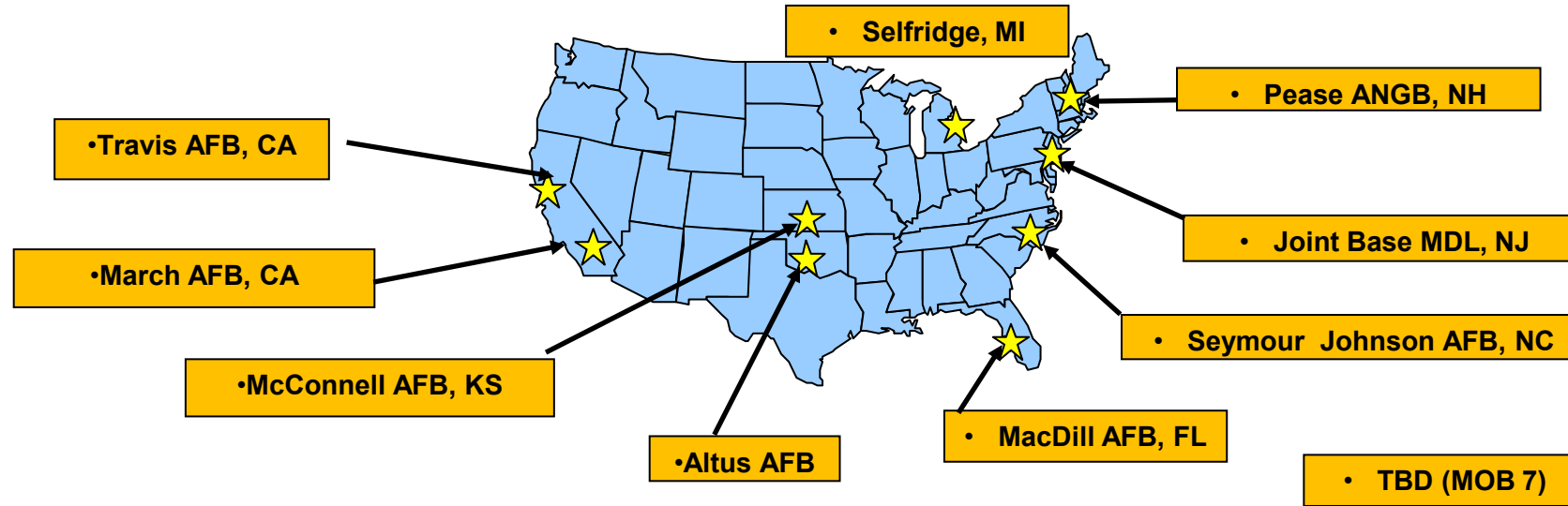

KC-46 AIRCREW TRAINING SYSTEM



- The KC-46 Aircrew Training System (ATS) program supports 10 sites (8 current, 1 and 1 notional) and 18 primary Weapon System Trainers, 15 Boom Operator Trainers, 8 Fuselage Trainers, 18 Part task trainers and computer-based Learning Management Systems training devices used to train aircrew members on the operations of the KC-46 at multiple bases.
- Lead Command: AMC, using organizations AETC
- Requirements: Aircrew instruction and training/ Student throughput, Contractor Logistics Support, TSSC, and modifications (sustainment and concurrency), visual database engineering support, cybersecurity, software integration, courseware development

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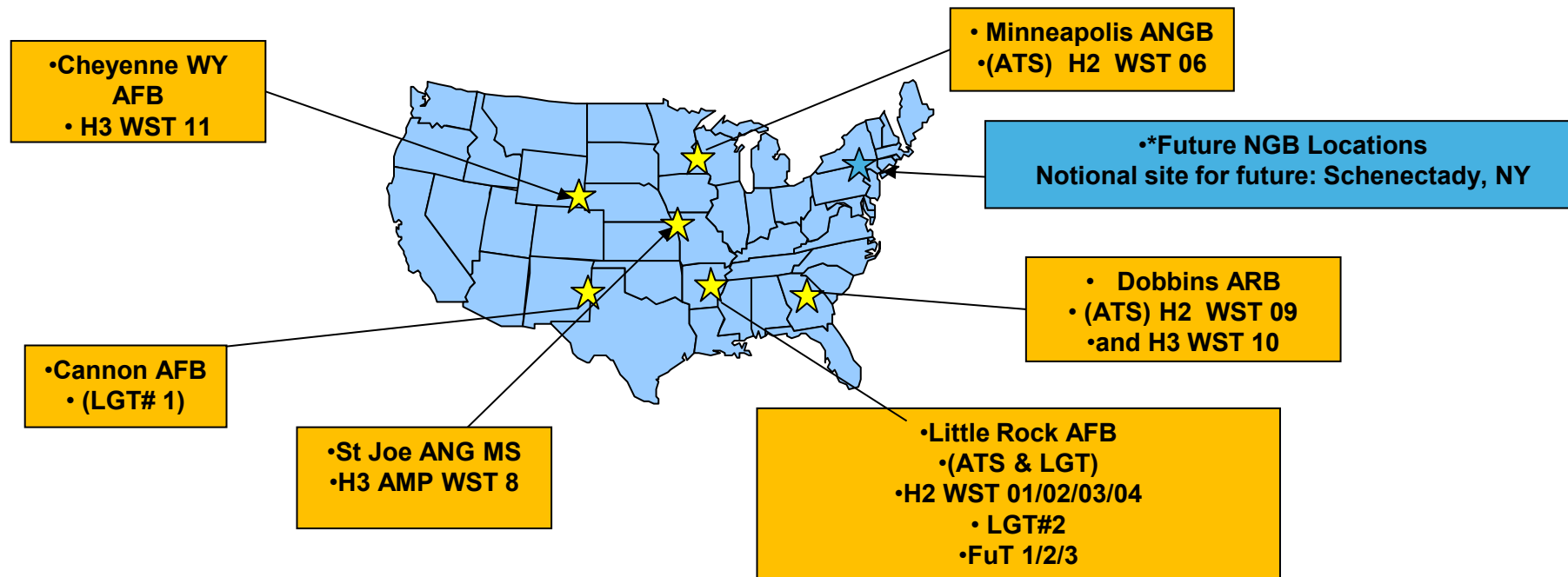
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C-130H AIRCREW TRAINING SYSTEM



- The C-130 Training System (TS) program supports 5 sites and 9 primary Weapon System Trainers, a learning center and a technical support system center (TSSC). The 2 C-130 Landing Gear Trainers (LGT) are a two-part training device used to train aircraft maintainers on the operations of the C-130H landing gear at Little Rock AFB and Cannon AFB.
- Lead Command: AMC, using organizations ANG, AFRC, and AETC
- Requirements: Aircrew instruction and training/100% Guaranteed Student throughput, Contractor Logistics Support, TSSC, and modifications (sustainment and concurrency)

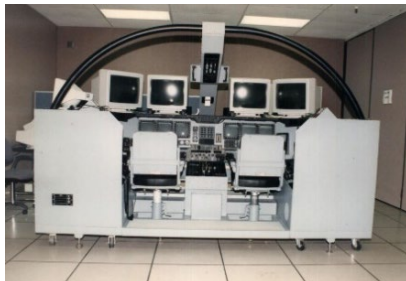

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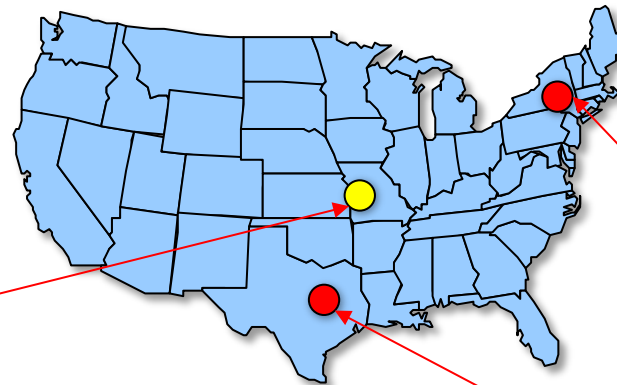
B-2 TRAINING SYSTEMS



- The B-2 Training Systems (TS) program consists of 12 Aircrew Training Devices (ATD) and 53 Maintenance Training Devices (MTD) and 1 Weapons Loading Device.
- Using Organizations: AFGSC, AETC
- Provide B-2 TS support for aircrew, maintenance, and weapons loading personnel to include Contractor Logistics Support, Technical Services Support, and Instruction & Training, concurrency and trainer-unique Reliability & Maintainability changes. Provide the warfighter with fully integrated training and maintain suite of ATDs and MTDs to meet warfighter requirements, continuously looking for ways to increase TS effectiveness and to reduce training costs.
- Requirements:
 - ATD/MTD: 95% availability
 - Response Time: 15 Min

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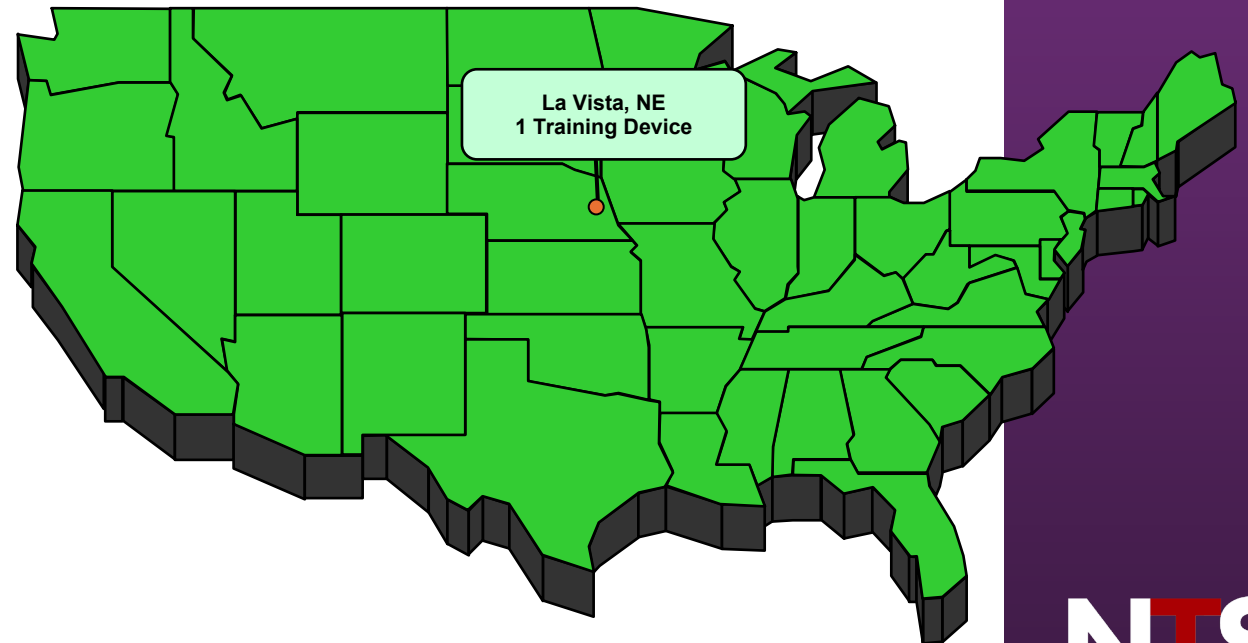

UPCOMING JSE OPPORTUNITIES



- VADOR Recompete – provides CI/CD capability for threat model integration on the Virtual Air Threat Solution (VATS) Operator-In-The-Loop (OITL) virtual adversary air representation
 - Expect RFP in May/June 25
- JSE CLS approach – requirements development in process to support reliability, availability, and maintainability (RAM) requirements, and operations as appropriate, across JSE-enabled sites.
 - Expect Solicitation in ~ 12 months
- Agnostic Cockpit – requirements development ongoing, completion anticipated by EoFY25
 - Potential Solicitation in Q3FY26
- Multiple platform integration efforts
