Following his graduation from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, his designation as a Naval Aviator, and training


in the F-14 Tomcat, Admiral Robb deployed nine times across the globe accumulating over 5,000 hours and 1,000 carrier landings.

After a tour flying Russian fighters in the Nevada desert, he commanded Fighter Squadron Fifty-One, Carrier Air Wing Nine, the Navy Fighter Weapons School (TOPGUN), and Carrier Strike Group Seven. As a Flag Officer, he managed all Naval Aviation Programs (N980) and was the Director of Navy Readiness (N43).

He joined USCENTCOM as the Director of Plans (J5) after 9/11, deploying to the Middle East in support of combat operations.

Retiring in 2006, he built a successful, small consulting business before joining the National Training and Simulation Association as President in June 2012.
